PHC to Disburse \$2.3 Million for COVID-19 Vaccine Programs

FAIRFIELD – Partnership HealthPlan of California (PHC) is distributing \$2.3 million in state funds to 32 entities (including provider offices, community-based organizations, universities, and hospital foundations) to help increase COVID-19 vaccination rates.

PHC, which administers Medi-Cal benefits for more than 618,000 members across 14 Northern California counties, received funds from the state Department of Health Care Services to support activities related to outreach and administration of COVID-19 vaccines for low-income community members. Throughout the pandemic, Medi-Cal recipients have had a lower rate of vaccination than the general population.

“PHC is thrilled to be part of this important, state-wide effort to promote vaccine equity in our local communities”, said PHC Chief Executive Officer Liz Gibboney. “These funds will support our community partners in increasing the vaccination rate among Medi-Cal members and the greater community.”

A request for proposal (RFP) process was held in September 2021 to determine grant recipients. The grant funds are being used for community outreach activities such as workshops, text campaigns, and media messaging, in addition to supporting operations for mobile and “pop-up” vaccine clinics in the community.

“We are happy to see such high engagement from our community partners in developing innovative strategies to outreach to Medi-Cal recipients,” said PHC Chief Medical Officer Dr. Robert Moore. “The projects we funded will go far in ensuring populations, including homebound community members and people of color, can get vaccinated within their communities.”

Under the scope of this grant, PHC requested organizations focus on outreach to young adults ages 12-25, people of color, and those who are homebound and unable to be

vaccinated in the community. Grant projects began in October 2021 and will run through March 2022.
