Important Provider Notice: #0094

Subject: NPI (National Provider Number) and BMI (Body Mass Index) on CHDP Claim Forms, Version 8

Reminder: Effective on or after 5/1/08, claims received by PHC without the required NPI number, the BMI (Body Mass Index), and the new Information Only (PM 160), Version 8, will be rejected and returned to the provider. Providers may continue to bill with the Medi-Cal number in conjunction with the NPI number, but the NPI number will be required.

Billing Policy Changes

Effective 5/1/08, PHC will require providers to collect the Body Mass Index (BMI) as part of its health assessment. Providers are reminded that they are responsible to assess all children for obesity at all well care visits at 2 – 18 years of age using the BMI percentile-for-age growth charts. Providers will be required to record the BMI percentile using the whole numbers on the PM 160 Version 8 claim form, specifically within the *Body Mass Index (BMI) Percentile* field.

Providers submitting claims with an NPI will be required to bill using the latest version of the CHDP Information Only (PM 160) claim form (Version 8). With this version, providers are required to include the appropriate Place of Service code and service location (name, street address, city, state and nine-digit mailing ZIP code where the service was provided). Providers should refer to the CHDP Information Only (*PM 160*) *Claim Form: Completion Instructions* section of the CHDP provider manual for additional information about these fields. Claims submitted using an NPI without the appropriate Place of Service code and service location may result in denial.
