Partnership HealthPlan Services

General Case Management: Telephonic, providing both episodic and long-term assistance to individuals who are having difficulty accessing care, coordinating services, and/or managing chronic health conditions.

Complex Case Management: Telephonic, assisting individuals who have multiple, complex, chronic health conditions through Collaboration with the interdisciplinary care team. Emphasis is placed on education, behavior/ lifestyle modifications.

Care Transitions: St. Joseph - Assisting individuals transition from hospital to home, or skilled nurse facility to home

IOPCM: Open Door (Eureka Community, Humboldt Open Door, North Country Clinic, and Open Door Mobile Services) providing intensive nursing education and case management support via both telephonically and face to face.

Growing Together Perinatal Program: telephonic, assisting expectant mothers in accessing and coordinating timely prenatal and postpartum care. Gift Cards given to members who complete the program.

Special Programs: telephonic, liaisons who collaborate with the interdisciplinary care team & community agencies to assist with coordination of care, access to services and/or education. Special Programs includes individuals who are part of California Children Services (CCS), Regional Center, and/or Genetically Handicapped Persons Program (GHPP).

Transportation: Medical Van, to/from medical appointments or procedures. Taxi reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

Telehealth Services: Partnering with Eureka Community Health Center (Open Door), Southern Humboldt Community Clinic, K'ima:w Medical Center, Redwoods Rural Health Center and United Indian Health to assist with access to primary and specialty care.
