Objectives:

- Understand the clinical background, specifications, and performance threshold definitions of the 2023 PCP QIP cervical, breast, and colorectal cancer screening measures.
- Apply documentation requirements to maximize adherence and measure performance in the delivery of cervical, breast, and colorectal cancer screening services.
- Identify best and promising practices that can be used to: address clinical workflows, improve interpersonal communication and member and staff education; eliminate barriers to access; improve outreach for patients from groups that have been historically, economically, and socially marginalized; and provide technical tips to facilitate early cancer detection screening services, especially for populations with higher incidence and mortality rates.
