506 members served by CS providers, and 637 members served by ECM providers.

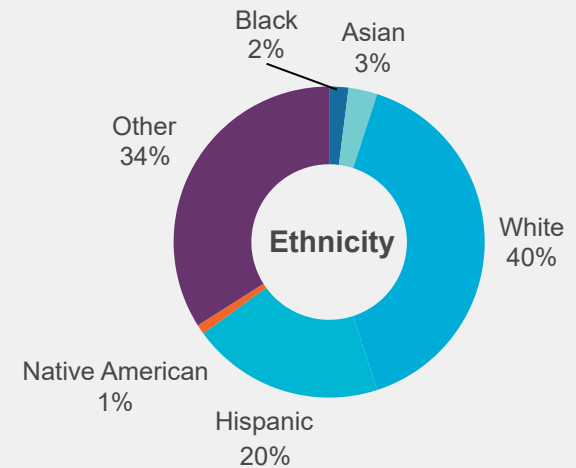
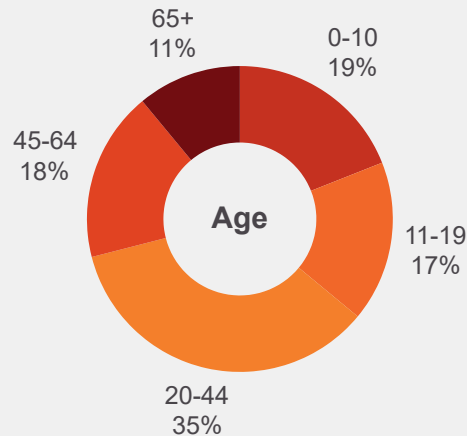


Top three CS services provided – Housing Transition and Navigation Services, Medically Tailored Meals, and Housing Tenancy



1.42 CS services per member enrolled

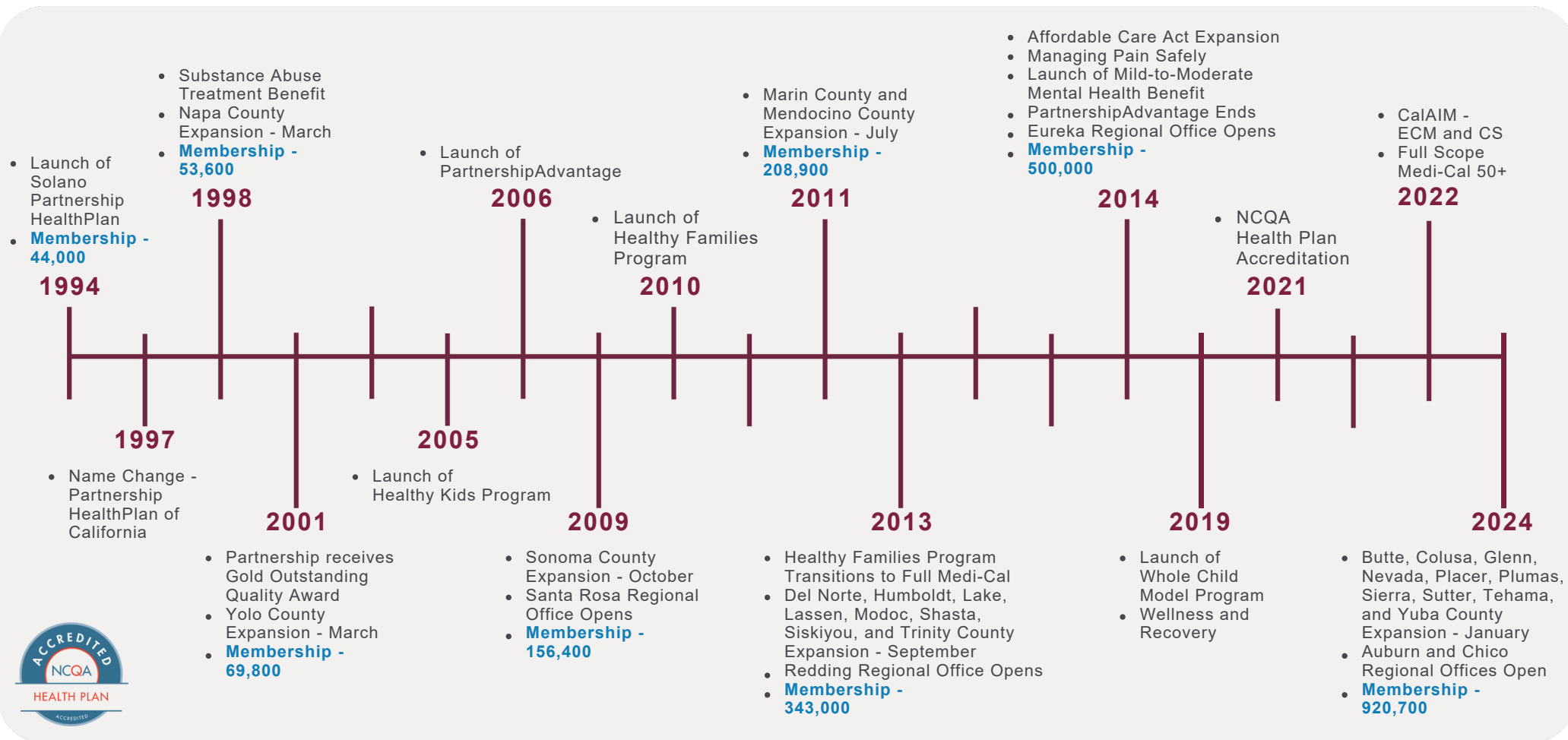
