

Community Supports Update: New Global Cap (as of January 1, 2025)

In late May 2025, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) informed managed care plans that the Community Supports (CS) services Short Term Post Hospitalization Housing (STPHH) and recuperative care are part of a new global cap, per the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) Waiver 1115 Demonstration.

The global cap for both STPHH and recuperative care became effective on January 1, 2025.

The global cap limits Partnership HealthPlan of California's members to 182 days within a 12-month rolling period for STPHH and/or recuperative care. This means that a member may not receive more than a combined six months of STPHH and recuperative care services during any rolling 12-month period.

Managed care plans must count the rolling 12-month period starting from the member's first date of utilization of STPHH and/or recuperative care — not from the date of authorization. Once 182 days of the services has been used by a member, the member will have to wait until the 12-month period ends to use the STPHH and/or recuperative care services again.
