FREED – Fix It Program

“Do you have a leaky faucet or need grab bars in your bathroom? FREED can have volunteers make minor home repairs or modifications which are health or safety related. Some of our services include installing grab bars to prevent falls; installing hand rails; repairing leaky faucets; support in building ramps; and minor entryway repairs. Seniors aged 60 and above living in Nevada or Sierra Counties are eligible for Fix It services.”

IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES (IHSS)

Placer County (IHSS) Program

“The In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program will help pay for services provided to you so that you can remain safely in your own home. To be eligible, you must be over 65 years of age, disabled, or blind. Disabled children are also potentially eligible for IHSS. IHSS is considered an alternative to out-of-home care, such as nursing homes or board and care facilities.”
