Disabled or Electricity Dependent Services – Disability Services and Legal Center

“Stay prepared for Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) events! If you rely on power for a life-sustaining medical device (CPAP, BiPAP, oxygen, refrigerated medication, etc.), you are encouraged to apply for the Disability Disaster Access and Resource (DDAR) program.

Those who qualify, the DDAR program can assist with: a loaner back-up battery system, creating an emergency plan, hotel/lodging support during outages, food/gas vouchers, Accessible Transportation.”
