“The DRC is a joint venture by the Sheriff and Probation Officer to assist in management of sanctions on probationers and offenders assigned to work in alternate custody programs, thereby, impacting jail overcrowding, while providing services and programs that can be delivered to offenders. Some of the programs offered include anger management, drug and alcohol counseling, bicycle repair, and life skills. These programs utilize Moral Reconciliation Therapy and evidence based practices and is facilitated by county or contract staff. Offenders are referred to the DRC by the Tehama County.”
