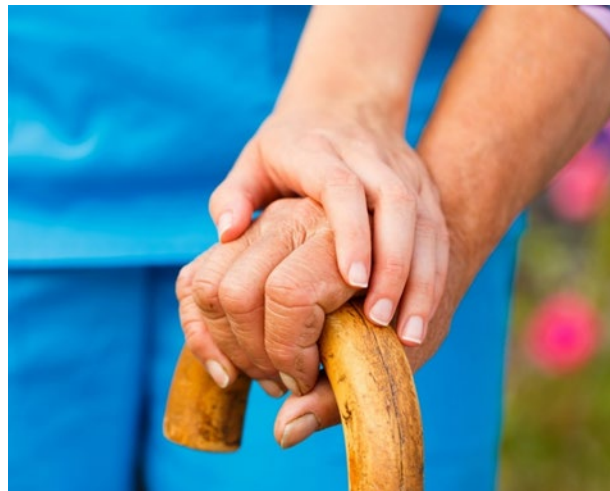
Golden Days Adult Day Health
