

Vaccines for School: Keeping Your Child Protected



Children need vaccines in order to go to school in California. Vaccines help protect children from various diseases.

When does my child need vaccines?

- Your child can get vaccines for kindergarten as early as 4 years old.
- Your pre-teen can get vaccines for middle school between 9 and 11 years old.

How do we get vaccines?

- Call your child's doctor to schedule a well-child visit and find out what vaccines your child needs.
- Ask your doctor if they have a walk-in clinic for vaccines.
- Call your county public health department. Most health departments offer vaccines at no cost for Partnership members.

Be sure your child has all their vaccines before school starts.
