
## YOUR CHILD NEEDS SHOTS FOR SCHOOL



Immunizations (shots) protect children from some diseases. To help students stay healthy, some shots are required to go to public school in California.

## What do we need to do?

- Make sure your child has a doctor.
- Call your child's doctor and find out what shots are needed



are an important part of that visit. Be

sure to do this before school starts!

- Your child can get kindergarten shots as early as 4 years old.
- Your pre-teen can get middle school shots between 9 and 11 years old.



## What if we cannot get an appointment before school starts?

- Call your child's doctor. Ask if they have a walk-in clinic for shots. Your doctor's phone number is on the front of your Partnership HealthPlan of California (PHC) ID card.
- Call your local Public Health Department. Most health departments have no-cost shots for PHC members.
- Call PHC Care Coordination at (800) 809-1350 if you need help finding the phone number for your local health department.
