

2025 Best Practices Topical Fluoride Varnish



Partnership Tools, Programs, and Promising Practices:

- Topical fluoride varnish can be applied at a well-care visit. Partnership offers \$25 gift card incentives for well-baby visits completed in the first 30 months and well-child visits ages 3-6 years through the Healthy Babies and Kids Growing Together Program. Patient Care:

- Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), Rural Health, and Tribal Health Dental Centers
 must update their coding practices for fluoride varnish applications to have their services
 counted toward the Topical Fluoride Varnish measure. Please see the Data and Coding
 section of this document for details (page 2).
- All counties have local oral health programs. Connect with the local oral health program in your county for free resources, training, and materials to implement fluoride varnish services in your primary care practice.
- Through your local oral health program, train provider teams to provide health education on dental fluoride varnish, prepare and complete a fluoride varnish, and document and code completion of the fluoride varnish.
- Utilize "flag" alerts in the EMR/EHR system or pre-visit planning tools that each care member/staff can use to identify and communicate to members/caregivers who are due for their screening services at every member/patient encounter.
- Use standing orders for internal staff to implement.
- Conduct chart scrubbing prior to the visit to determine if screening/preventive services are due.
- Stock exam rooms with pre-prepared fluoride varnish kits to streamline completion.
- Provide parents/caregivers with health education on topical fluoride and the importance of dental hygiene and regular dental visits for their kids. Health education materials can be found on local oral health program websites.

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- If practice offers dental services, schedule the child's next dental visit during check-out, or as part of the rooming process.
- Provide parents/caregivers with a list of pediatric dentists in their area who accept Medi-Cal Dental. Lists can be found on local oral health program websites.

Equity Approaches:

- Use the well-child visit to connect patients and parents/caregivers with dental care. Provide caregivers with information that preventative dental care is a covered Medi-Cal dental benefit for their child and an important part of their preventative care.
- Assess barriers to completing regular dental visits and plan interventions to address these barriers.
- Ensure member/patient information is consistent, welcoming, in plain person-centered, language appropriate, and delivered in traditional and electronic applications, per patient's preference.
- Having a conversation with parents/caregivers to confirm that information about topical fluoride varnish and dental care is mutually understood, parents/caregivers agree with any plans made, and they were given the opportunity to ask questions.

Data and Coding:

- Submit claims and encounter data within 90 days of service.
- Code fluoride varnish treatment as part of encounter/claims submission.
 - Medical Provider CPT 99188
 - Dental Provider CDT D1206 or D1208 <u>and</u> ICD Z29.3 (Note: both ICD and CDT codes must be used in Dental Center billing for services to count toward measure)
